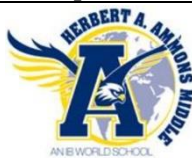

Final Report Card

For your convenience, final Report Cards can be printed from the student and or parent portal. Envelopes will **NOT** be furnished by the school. Remember, you must put a forever stamp on the envelope as the postage requirements may change. No Report Cards will be sent home unless a stamped, self-addressed envelope has been provided by the student. Report Cards may be picked up in the main office after June 30th, by a legal guardian only.
