If I could I would make it longer and elaborate more.

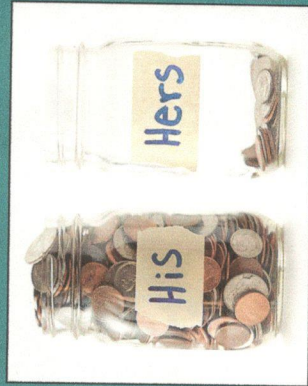

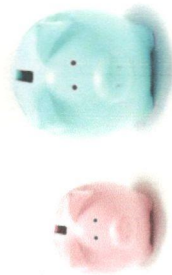

- .Women in Texas have a big rally around an all mens bank for equal pay



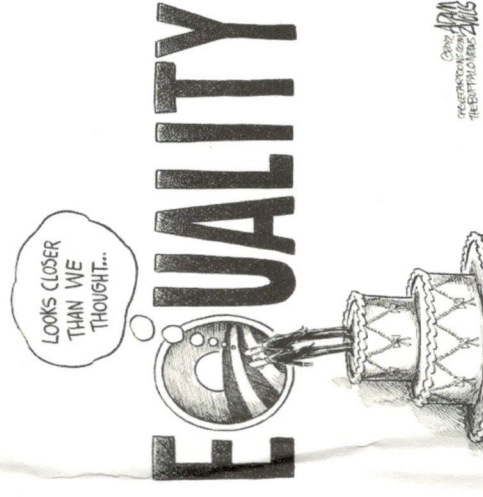
## Pro Argument(they think it still exists)
